

Il Molinaccio, La Spinosa, Vino Nobile di Montepulciano 2018

Despite being a bit discreet, La Spinosa eventually demonstrates its pretty fragrances of wildflowers and herbs, particularly anise. There is a nice pop of red cherry on the palate and some chinotto to lend intrigue. Long grainy tannins stretched out rather than compress in this midweight and buoyant Vino Nobile. Fermentation is spontaneous with indigenous yeast and maceration is a long 60 days. Aged in two 25hL French Allier oak casks, the total production is 6,600 bottles.
